Ku Jin Keat seized gold in Kata event.

Ku Jin Keat created history by becoming the first Malaysian to win gold from the Kata event of the Asian Games to break powerhouse Japan's dominance in the discipline.

In the karate events which started at the Guangdong Gymnasium on November 24th, seasoned campaigner, Jin Keat successfully secured a gold medal.

After securing a bronze in his first participation in the 2002 Asian Games in Busan, South Korea, Jin Keat went one better to win a silver in the Doha edition, four years ago.

Today, the 35-year-old karate exponent completed his illustrious career by winning the gold from the Men's Individual Kata after taming his Japanese opponent Oki Itaru 3-2.

Jin Keat beat Faizal Zainuddin from Indonesia 4-1 in the semifinal before battling with the Japanese exponent in the final.
