

# Generosity Touched The Hearts Of 50 Orphans

Cofreth Recreation Committee (CRC) organized a humble visit to Rumah Anak Yatim Limpahan Kasih, an orphanage home location in Puchong which was held last December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

The home, which holds up to a total of 50 boys and girls aged between 7 to 16 years old, is run by Non-Government Organization and relies fully on donations from the public for their day to day expenditures. In addition to that, the home also started a small tailoring shop, a café, and a nursery selling plants to further support their daily expenditures. The tailoring shop and café are managed by widows who have children at home and in need of income.

From the cash and kind collected from Cofreth staff and contributions given by Cofreth itself, the CRC Team managed to donate a huge bulk of food and daily needs for the children (i.e. pillows, blankets, bed sheets, towels, tooth brushes, tooth paste, bath soap, detergent, rice, milk, milo, sugar, stationery and etc.) to the home. On top of that, the CRC Team still had enough cash to purchase electrical items such as iron and ironing boards, stand fans, vacuum cleaner, clothes stand, DVD player and etcetera.

On the morning of the visit, Cofreth staff gathered at the Headquarter and coordinated the collected items to be sent to the home. Upon arrival, they were greeted by the children of the home with excitement to see many new items for them. The children helped to carry the donated items from the cars into the home. Once the items were officially handed over, the orphanage's warden, Pn. Norhayati, gave a thank you speech. Nor Niza Md Ajib, Cofreth's Human Resource Manager and CRC member, also followed up with her short speech.

With all the formalities over, everybody headed across to the playing field to play some games with the children. CRC had organized some telematch games and everybody broke into 6 teams comprising of the children and Cofreth staffs. There were lots of fun and laughter with the games. The children and Cofreth staffs enjoyed themselves tremendously. At the end of the games, lunch was served at the playing field and the children were delighted upon seeing that lunch was Kentucky Fried Chicken. After lunch, the judge announced the winners of the telematch and the children were very happy with their winning prizes.

It was really a very satisfying feeling to be able to give so much to the children and to see their happy faces really touches one's heart. We have so much to give yet most of the time, we take things for granted whereas these children do not even have a family.

CRC team is looking forward to organize another event such as this with another orphanage in the near future.
